

Korea Pet Importation Changes

After 1 December 2011, pets must be microchipped, have a valid health certificate within 10 days of flight arrival, and have a current rabies vaccination which is at least 30 days old but less than 12 months old; regardless if the vaccine is a 3 year duration rabies vaccination. Pets less than 3 months of age are not required a rabies vaccination. A Rabies Neutralizing Antibody Test (FAVN) from an internationally approved laboratory with a positive result equivalent to at least 0.5 IU/ml or higher should be performed not less than 3 months and not more than 24 months prior to shipment to Korea. Animals from rabies-free regions or under 90 days old are not required to have a rabies neutralizing antibody test.
