

PCS to Taiwan

1. The pet must have a current rabies vaccination and a microchip placed greater than 6 months prior to shipment.
2. A FAVN antibody test result must be at least 6 months old but not more than 2 years old.
 - a. If the pet is current on its rabies vaccination, than a FAVN blood sample can be drawn and submitted at the time of the first visit.
 - b. If the pet is not current on the rabies vaccination but has had the vaccination before, a rabies vaccination will be given at the first visit and then a FAVN blood sample will be drawn 10-14 days following vaccination.
 - c. If the animal is less than one year old or has no history of vaccination, two rabies vaccinations will need to be given 30 days apart and then a FAVN blood sample taken 30 days after the second rabies vaccination.
3. At least 30 days Prior to shipment, the owner needs to apply for an import permit by submitting the following:
 - a. Application form A-2
 - b. A current rabies vaccination certificate singed in any ink other than black with the breed, sex, age, microchip number, date of vaccination, and whether the vaccination was a primary or a booster.
 - c. FAVN antibody test result that is greater than or equal to 0.5 IU/ml and dated no less than 180 days and no more than 2 years prior to shipment.
 - d. A copy of the importer's passport.
 - e. Submit this information by e-mail, fax or mail. See the attachment for this information.
4. APHIS Form 7001 certified by the USDA. A military veterinarian can not sign for this paperwork.
5. A health certificate that is less than 10 days old.
6. A letter of acclimation.
