## COMMUNITY COLLEGE OF THE AIR FORCE

All enlisted personnel are eligible to receive an Associate's of Applied Science degree from the Air Force. This degree correlates with the member's AFSC and helps Airmen and Space Professionals achieve their education goals by capitalizing on job-related training and education as part of the degree program. Depending on the length of a member's technical training, they may be eligible to receive college credits just from completing

tech school. Additional upgrade training, follow-on training, professional military education are also awarded college credits. These credits are often transferable to other colleges, and can help service members get a jump start on their academic goals.

To complete a CCAF degree, students must complete 24 semester hours (SH) of technical education, 6 SH of Leadership, Management, and Military Studies (LMMS), 15 SH of Program Electives, and 15 SH of General Education.

CCAF has implemented many policy changes over the last

year that have impacted some degree programs. Please contact the Education Center to review your CCAF degree progress and put together a plan to complete your program. You can use a combination of military credits, college courses, and CLEP/DSST credits to meet all requirements.

The latest CCAF policy change awards 5 SH of LMMS for students who have completed Basic Military Training (BMT) between 17 October 2019 and 3 January 2021. Those who complete BMT after 4 January will receive 4 SH of LMMS.

If you believe you should have received this credit, and it is not reflected on your CCAF web progress report (viewable in the Air Force Virtual Education Center), please provide the Education Center with your BMT graduation certificate and CCAF will apply the credits to your program.

## WAPS TESTING

*The 21E5 Weighted Airman Promotion System (WAPS) testing cycle starts 1 May 2021, with the first test at Offutt AFB on the 4th of May. Contact your Unit WAPS Monitor (UWM) to sign your AF Form 1566 for your test date. You should also review your Data Verification Record, which reflects whether or not you are eligible and your promotion record is weighable or non-weighable.*

*A weighable record means all the weighted factor data elements (Enlisted Performance Reports, Decorations, Promotion Fitness Examination, Specialty Knowledge Test, Time-in-Grade and Time-in-Service) are present and you will receive promotion consideration during the original select run.*

We now offer a virtual tuition assistance briefing on the first and third Wednesday of each month for required initial counseling and as an option for follow-up counseling. If you have not used tuition assistance previously, completion of an interest assessment is required prior to attending. You have several options: the Kuder Career Interests Assessment - we recommend this one ([dantes.kuder.com](https://dantes.kuder.com)), The O\*Net Interest Profiler ([mynextmove.org/explore/ip](https://mynextmove.org/explore/ip)), or the CareerOneStop Interest Assessment ([careeronestop.org/toolkit/careers/interest-assessment.aspx](https://careeronestop.org/toolkit/careers/interest-assessment.aspx)). You will need to send your inventory results (RIASEC score) to [education6@us.af.mil](mailto:education6@us.af.mil) before attending the briefing so make sure to "Print" them to a PDF.
